**Option 1:** The easiest and slowest is Level 1 15amp on site charging. Just select Level 1 Charging and you can plug into our 15amp socket on your site (Looks like household plug - 30amp and 50amp connections are prohibited on site due to electrical limits).

**Option 2:** We have installed three pay-as-you-go Level 2 80amp Electric Vehicle chargers at the pool for your use.

As a reminder, all member EV vehicles (cars, trucks, golfcarts, etc.) must be registered and ALL EV charging at the resort must be pre-approved and paid for.
