We will REQUIRE that your guests have a pass in advance of arrival to make sure everyone is accounted for and so we can maintain a secure environment. Did you know we created a new guest pass system for you? You just need your guest's email. Please make sure you log into the Portal and get familiar with it. Click on Manage Guests at the bottom of the check in/out tile. Use this system to make sure your guests are not mistakenly turned away at the gate and to prevent traffic backups onto Old US 23 and M59.


