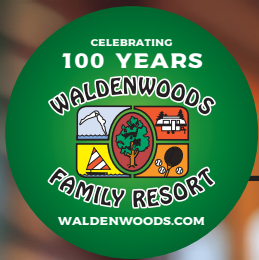

March - April

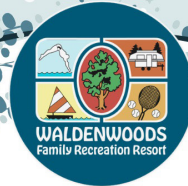
